## AGREEMENT FOR ADJUNCTIVE TREATMENT ONLY

ADJUNCTIVE TREATMENT: There are occasions where the Clinician might agree to provide adjunctive
services to a Client who is in primary treatment with another provider. In these cases, it is understood
that the adjunctive treatment will be focused and time-limited, usually limited to 10 sessions, in support of the primary treatment provided elsewhere. Because of potential problems in effectively coordinating
treatment, it is understood that the Clinician, as an adjunctive therapist, may at any time make a clinical
decision to terminate adjunctive treatment and will notify the Client and primary therapist of this decision. It is understood that upon termination of adjunctive treatment by either Client or Clinician, the Clinician will
nave no further clinical obligation to the Client.
